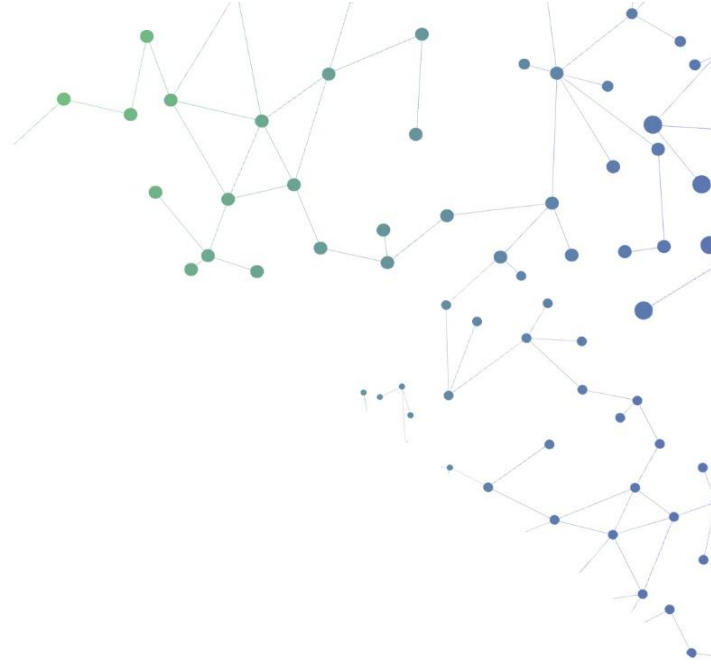

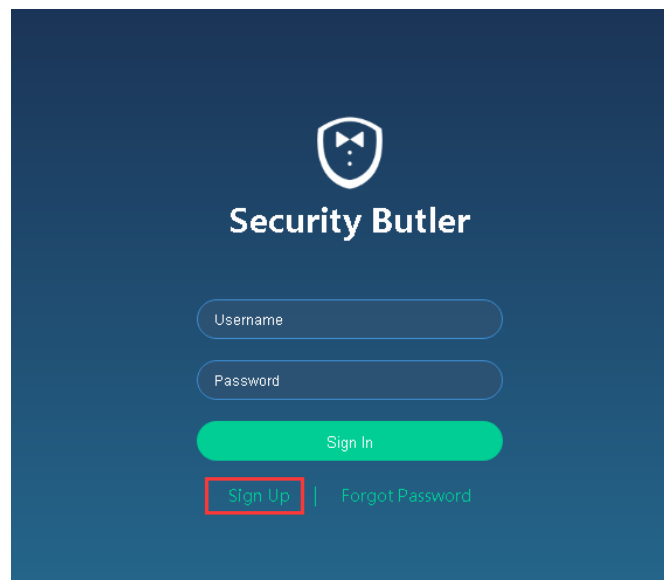
1. Function Introduction

Security Butler performs complex firewall log reviews and correlation, alert and highlight relevant and critical security incidents for administrators and enables quick emergency response, all from the convenience of a cloud-based portal 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. 
2. Configuration Guide

2.1 Sign Up for New User

1. Go to "<https://butler.sangfor.com/>" , then click on the **Sign Up** button to register an account.



2. On the Sign Up page, fill in the necessary information and click on the **Save** button as figure below:
